Alternatively, applicants expecting to complete their PhD, MD, or MD/PhD prior January 1st 2019 are also able to apply but will have to provide proof of completing all degree requirements prior to starting this postdoctoral position. The normal hours of work are 40 hours per week for a full-time postdoctoral fellow (pro-rated for those holding a partial appointment) recognizing that the needs of the employee's research and training and the needs of the supervisors' research program may require flexibility in the performance of the employee's duties and hours of work.
