In collaboration with the Principal Investigator the candidate in this role will work independently performing a wide range of specialized techniques and experiments. The overarching goal will be to use classical and molecular genetic approaches along with sophisticated behavioral assays to study roles for glia-neuron communication in the regulation of Drosophila circadian behavior and sleep. The role will include collection of Drosophila adults for genetic crosses, data analysis, interpretation of results, statistical analysis, and production of figures/tables for publication. The role will include supervision and training of others in the laboratory and helping to manage laboratory operations (ordering supplies and maintaining equipment).
