**Job Description** 

The Center for Bioenergy and Bioproducts at Auburn University invites applications for the position of Post-Doctoral Fellow. This is a benefits-eligible, non-tenure track position with an initial appointment of one year, renewable up to a maximum of four years based on performance and funding availability.
