Under close supervision of the Principal Investigator, the senior research technician will conduct a variety of routine experiments following established procedures and protocols, which will primarily include performing assays, tissue culture, and animal work. This technician will also record test results, analyze data using basic statistics, and maintain laboratory equipment and supplies.

What We're Looking For

Basic Requirements:

- Master's degree with one or more years of laboratory experience or a bachelor's degree in science with at least three years of laboratory experience
- Perform routine techniques in tissue culture working with both primary cell culture as well as cell lines
- Performs routine assays, such as PCR, immunohistochemistry, western blot, and ELISA.
- Animal (mouse) work, including animal restraint, intraperitoneal injections, and tissue dissections
- Record accurate records and results of experiments, with limited data interpretation such as basic statistics, graph plotting, and image acquisition
- Maintain laboratory equipment/stocks and orders/keep inventory of supplies
