We will consider a candidate's past outputs, current research programme, likelihood to obtain future funding support, and potential and enthusiasm to develop their own research leadership in Volcanology.

ASE collaborates closely with the Earth Observatory of Singapore, and other schools in NTU's College of Science. ASE also has existing research partnerships that may facilitate collaborations in the region.
