The successful candidate will apply excellent written and interpersonal communication skills to: (1) Develop and maintain a nationally and internationally recognized, extramurally funded research program involving interdisciplinary collaboration with a research focus on fossils, rocks, and extant biological materials, making use of analytical equipment including but not limited to osteohistological thin-sectioning tools, advanced microscopy and imaging systems, geochemical analyses using analytical instruments such as IRMS, TIMS, MC-ICP-MS, ICP-OES, ICP-MS, and LA-ICP-MS, multivariate statistical analysis and advanced data analyses techniques in the R programming language (including but not limited to: geometric morphometrics, functional diversity, isotopic analysis, biostratigraphy, elemental analysis, etc).
