Required Qualifications: Ph.D. in one of the disciplinary fields of Biology; tenured full professor or associate professor with at least three (3) years in rank and previous administrative experience in higher education.

Preferred Qualifications: Experience developing strategies for faculty mentoring and support; record of excellence and innovation in teaching, and experience with curriculum and program development; management of budgets and research grants, and knowledge of various funding opportunities; experience in promoting diversity and inclusion by recruiting, retaining, and graduating underrepresented students; demonstrated ability to understand and balance the needs of distinct programs within a multidisciplinary department; demonstrated ability to implement and oversee an effective departmental governance structure.
