Comprising faculty in both the College of Arts and Sciences and the School of Medicine, the Department of Biochemistry and Cell Biology is an active, collaborative community of scholars with broad research interests dedicated to both scientific discovery and fostering inclusive education at undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate levels. In addition, the University maintains professionally staffed core facilities to support research, including cryo-electron microscopy, proteomics, next generation sequencing and light microscopy.
