Specifically, this position will provide instruction in the fundamental concepts and



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facts related to the biochemistry and molecular biology of human homeostasis and disease, as well as the application to biochemical processes to human health. This individual will serve as a member of a team of biochemistry faculty in the planning and delivery of relevant content in a multi-discipline, systems-based medical curriculum.

Applicant must hold a PhD in Biochemistry, Cell Biology, Molecular Biology, or an equivalent terminal degree.

Ideal candidates have 1-5 years of teaching experience after receiving their terminal degree, preferably at a DO or MD medical school. Teaching experience should include biochemistry (preferably in large team-taught medical-level courses); an ability to teach nutritional biochemistry is considered an asset. Candidates must have a proven record of scholarly activity (e.g., research publications, grants) consistent with the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor.

#### **Essential Functions:**

Work hours necessary to perform job requirements satisfactorily on a regular basis. Manage absence from work in

responsible manner to ensure service to clients, work teams, and coworkers. Comply with Marian University policies

and practices and seeking clarification of them when necessary.
