Finnish proficiency is considered an advantage. The candidate should be familiar with modern pedagogical approaches (e.g. constructive learning, case-based learning, project based learning) and have the ability to effectively use digital tools and resources in teaching.

Applicants must possess a Doctorate (or be near completion of a doctoral degree) in information systems science, business information technology or a closely related field. Between 50-70% of the work duties are related to teaching, depending on the Lecturer career system level of the person selected for the position.
