8. Matters of Consideration

? If no suitable candidates are found, the number of hires may be reduced, or no selections may be made.

- If the candidate fails to obtain a doctoral degree at the time of appointment.

The appointment and acceptance will also be canceled if the candidate, or someone closely related to the candidate, engages in any form of misconduct, such as making improper requests, exerting pressure, or offering financial benefits in relation to the hiring process, resulting in their unfair selection.

? Appointment will be restricted if the candidate is subject to disqualifications, set out in the State Public Officials Act, (Article 33) or the DGIST Regulation on Faculty Personnel Management, (Article 12).
