2018 and over 300 undergraduate majors. A new M.S. program began in 2017 and a second degree option in Software Development began in 2016. The CS program has been ABET-accredited since 1989.

Existing faculty research areas include computer vision, distributed computing, internet of things, Autonomous Robotics, machine learning, multimedia, networking, and software engineering. The department is growing and if the growth continues more faculty members may be hired in the future. <http://computerscience.missouristate.edu/undergraduate/>.

The successful candidate will be hired with tenure at the rank of Professor. The Department Head works on a 12-month basis, with an initial 5-year term with annual review and the potential for re-appointment to additional terms.
