Biomedical/Anatomical/Physiological Sciences - the successful candidate will have an educational and research focus in the Biomedical Sciences or a related field, in particular the Anatomical and Physiological Sciences. Additional expectations include the ability to deliver and facilitate team-based or case-based learning, both in-person and through an online modality.

Qualifications: Ph.D. degree or equivalent in the Biomedical/Anatomical/Physiological Sciences, a related field or medical degree from an accredited institution is required. Post-doctoral position at an accredited institution of higher learning and knowledge of cadaver dissection (actual and/or virtual) and preparation of anatomy instructional material are desirable.
